Meeting Opening:

Supervisor Wadsworth called the meeting to order at 5:00PM and Town Clerk Wright led the group in the pledge to the flag. Supervisor Wadsworth requested a moment of silence to be held for service men and women serving around the world.

I. Regular Business:

Approval of Minutes:

Councilmember Deming moved and Councilmember Mix seconded the motion to approve the July 14, 2022 meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried with Wadsworth-aye, Deming-aye, Maxwell-abstain, and Mix-aye. Nays: None.

Councilmember Deming moved and Councilmember Maxwell seconded the motion to approve Abstract #8 and Vouchers 411 through 466 as they stand.

Motion passed with voting as follows: Wadsworth-aye, Mix-aye, Maxwell-aye, and Deming-aye. Nays: None.

II. New Business:

Don McLane appeared before the Board to report a tree that has fallen over the Jaycox Creek between the Village and the new large culvert that goes under Lima Road. The Highway Department was already aware of the tree and will take action when approved. D. McLane also complimented the Highway Superintendent and the Highway Department on the great job of clearing out the creek in that location.

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Sarah Santora appeared before the Board as a representative of Senator Gallivan's office. Because of the redistricting, Senator Gallivan will no longer be the representative of Livingston County. He wanted the Town residents to know he will be available until December 31, 2022.

Councilmember Mix moved and Councilmember Maxwell seconded the motion to increase Deputy Clerk Trish Veley to \$19.00 per hour or \$39,520 per year salary to start on the first day of the next payroll. Motion carried with Wadsworth-aye, Deming-aye, Maxwell-aye, and Mix-aye. Nays: None.

The Board agreed to compensate the Board of Assessment Review members the previously approved rate of \$125 for their contribution to that process.

III. Old Business:

The Board continued the discussion regarding the Livingston County Water Sewer Authority proposed regional water supply project. No action was taken.

A draft Short-Term Rental Law was reviewed. Several members of the public were present, and much discussion ensued. No action was taken.

The Board discussed the location of the gazebo previously presented by the Geneseo Garden Club as a donation to the Town. Highway Superintendent Larry Levey met with members of the club and satisfied with the location, the handicap ramp, and the stone foundation. Councilmember Mix moved and Councilmember Maxwell seconded the motion to approve the installation in the spot that satisfies the right of way requirements and is handicap accessible. Motion carried with Wadsworth-aye, Deming-aye, Maxwell-aye, and Mix-aye. Nays: None.
